RECOGNITION: Recipients of the Junior Leader's Service Award may be awarded a medal, a ribbon, and certificate.

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. The Junior Leader's Service Award application must be completed in September and sent with all documentation requested to your District RR Director postmarked on or before September 30.
- 2. The points recorded on this application must represent those earned September 1-August 31 except when notated by star (*).
- 3. The District RR Director will give recognition for this award during the annual district conference.

CRITERIA: The following are the minimum requisites to receive the Junior Leader's Service Award:

- 1. The Junior Leader's Service Award is limited to Junior Group Leaders (Junior Commanders), Senior Patrol Leaders, Asst Senior Patrol Leaders, and Asst. Patrol Leaders.
- 2. Applicants must be at least 11 years of age, having not yet reached 18 years of age.
- Applicants must be recipients of the Adventure Rangers "Adventure Bronze" award or the Expedition Rangers "E1" award.
- 4. The applicant must consistently wear a clean and professional Royal Rangers uniform, as defined by his outpost, and in compliance with current national Royal Rangers uniform standards (see RoyalRangers.com).
- 5. The applicant must earn at least 225 points using the evaluation sheet from each of the following three evaluation categories below:
 - Advancement & Training: 75 points minimum
 - Leadership Responsibilities: 75 points minimum
 - Local Responsibilities: 75 points minimum

CATEGORY DESCRIPTIONS

Advancement & Training

- 1. Earn 10 points for each completed level.
- 2. Earn 20 points for each completed level.
- 3. Earn 10 points each for each junior training camp/event completed.
- 4. Earn 2 points for each leadership merit completed. Only AR and ER merits qualify.
- 5. Earn 5 points for each FCF membership level attained.
- 6. Earn 5 points for each FCF Trappers Brigade level attained.

Leadership Responsibilities

- 7. Earn 10 points for attendance with outpost at the annual district camp/powwow.
- 8. Earn 5 points for each district/division/section event attended.
- 9. Earn 5 points for each outpost event/activity conducted.
- 10. Earn 5 points for each Junior or National Training Camp/Event staff served.
- 11. Earn 5 points for each National and/or Regional event attended.
- 12. Earn 10 points for each missions project participated in. (Approved missions projects are RRI, BGMC Master's Toolbox, PathFinders Missions, and STL Christmas Project.)
- 13. Earn 5 points for each local outpost award ceremony participated in.
- 14. Earn 5 points for every service project completed at the outpost level.
- 15. Earn 10 points for each national AG activity attended. (General Council, National Fine Arts Festival, etc.)

Local Responsibilities

- 16. Earn 5 points for being a member of a chartered outpost.
- 17. Earn 2 points for each patrol staff meeting attended.
- 18. Earn ½ point for each outpost meeting attended.
- 19. Earn 10 points for regular attendance in a Sunday school/small group.
- 20. Earn 10 points for regular attendance and participation in the your ministry at your local church.
- 21. Earn 2 points for each devotion presented at a Royal Rangers event.
- 22. Earn 2 points for each time you assist the instructor while teaching a merit.
- 23. Earn 5 points for each boy you personally led to Christ during the past year.
- 24. Earn 2 points for each boy you personally recruited into your local Royal Rangers outpost.
- 25. Earn 1 point for each boy you personally assisted in the completion of three advancement steps.
